
The New Theologian

Saint Symeon, a native of Paphlagonia and born in 949, became a monk of the Studite Monastery as a young man, under the guidance of the elder Symeon the Pious. Looking for a stricter life, he migrated to the Monastery of Saint Mamas in Constantinople, and was abbot there for twenty-five years. Later, having incurred animosity, he organized a new monastery, where he lived out his life in peace.

Symeon wrote much on the divine light, especially relating this to the Holy Transfiguration. He is one of the influences on the use of Hesychasm as a form of monastic prayer. In Saint Symeon Byzantine mysticism reached its peak. He was in the spiritual tradition of Saint John Climacus and Saint Maximos the Confessor, and in recent times there has been a marked appreciation of his spiritual writings.

Marvelling at the heights of prayer and holiness to which he attained, and the loftiness of the teachings of his life and writings on divine things, the Church calls him "the New Theologian." Only to two others, John the Evangelist and Gregory, Patriarch of Constantinople, has the Church given the name "theologian." Saint Symeon reposed in 1022 on March 12, but since this always falls in the Great Fast, the Greek Church keeps his feast today.
