#### **Undying spirit of the Carpathians**

Bishop and Martyr Theodore (Romzha) was born on April 14, 1911, in the village of Velykyi Bychkiv, Zakarpattia to a family of railroad workers. He finished his theological studies at the Papal

Gregorian University in Rome. In 1938 he became pastor in the mountain villages of Berezevo and Nyzhnii Bystryi outside of Khust. Beginning with the fall of 1939 he taught philosophy and was spiritual director at the Uzhorod seminary. On September 24, 1944, soon after the arrival of the Soviet Army, he was ordained to the episcopacy.

Because Bishop Theodore bravely refused to cooperate with the authorities in

the liquidation of the Greek-Catholic Church and separate from the Roman Apostolic See, government organs decided to destroy him. On October 27, 1947 a military vehicle ran into the bishop's horse-carriage. When the soldiers saw that he didn't die in the accident, they beat him and his companions into unconsciousness. On November 1 of that year when Bishop Theodore was beginning to recover, he was poisoned in the Mukachiv hospital by workers cooperating with the security services. He died a martyr for the faith.

"According to the instructions of Khruschev, a member of the Politburo (Central Committee of the Communist Party) of Ukraine and the first secretary of the same, according to the plan developed by the Ministry of State Security in Ukraine and approved by Khruschev, Romzha was eliminated in Mukachiv. As the head of the Greek-Catholic Church, he had actively opposed the forced uniting of Greek-Catholics to Orthodoxy." - From a letter of Pavlo Sudoplatov, general of state security, to delegates of the 23rd Assembly of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union.

#### Незнищенна душа Карпат

Священномученик Теодор (Ромжа) народився 14 квітня 1911 р. у с. Великий Бичків на Закарпатті в сім'ї залізничника. Богословські студії закінчив у Папському Григоріянському

Університеті в Римі. У 1938 р. став парохом у гірських селах Березів та Нижній Бистрий в околицях Хуста. З осені 1939 р. викладав філософію і був духівником Ужгородської Духовної Академії. Невдовзі після вступу радянських військ 24 вересня 1944 р. відбулася його єпископська хіротонія.

Оскільки Владика Теодор рішуче відмовився співпрацювати з владою у

ліквідації Греко-Католицької Церкви і відстоював єдність із Римським Апостольським Престолом, державні органи прийняли рішення про його знищення. 27 жовтня 1947 р. військовий автомобіль наїхав на кінний екіпаж Владики. Коли солдати побачили, що Єпископ не загинув в аварії, вони до непритомності побили його і супутників. 1 листопада того ж року Кир Теодор, який почав видужувати, був отруєний у Мукачівській лікарні співробітниками держбезпеки. Загинув як мученик за віру.

"За вказівкою члена Йолітбюро ЦК ВКП(б) і першого секретаря ЦК ВКП(б) України Хрущова, за планом, розробленим Міністерством Державної Безпеки УРСР і схваленим Хрущовим, у м. [Patristic Wisdom on the Lord's Prayer Continued]

## Thy Will be Done on Earth as It is in Heaven

We who are praying are still on earth ourselves. And since we reckon that all the inhabitants of heaven fulfill the will of God in heaven, it comes naturally to us to ask that we too on earth should succeed in fulfilling the divine will. That will come about, logically, if we do nothing outside that will. When we have perfectly accomplished it, although we are still remaining on earth we shall be like the heavenly beings and will bear equally with them the image of the heavenly Being. In the end we shall inherit the kingdom of heaven. Those who come to take our place on earth will ask that they too may become like us who are then in heaven.

In addition it is recorded that our Lord after His resurrection said to the eleven Apostles: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me" (Mt 28:18). Jesus claimed in short to have received authority on earth equal to that which He has in heaven. The things of heaven, at the beginning, have been illuminated by the Word. And at the end of time, thanks to the authority granted to the Son of God, the things of earth will be like those of heaven which is already perfect.

So then it is clear that Christ is calling His disciples to work faithfully with Him by means of their prayers. That all earthly events may come to be transformed by the authority that Christ has received both in heaven and on earth, this ought to be our prayer.
